#### **ABOUT THE EVENT**

The Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996, which consolidated the Indian law on arbitration, was based on the UNCITRAL Model Law, there were significant lacunae in the 1996 Act, which were sought to be addressed by the Indian courts in an ad hoc manner. Consequently, there was a legislative rethink which led to a wide-ranging amendment by way of the Amendment Act 2015. A more controversial Amendment Act of 2019 has been passed and partially notified. The speaker will address the evolution of the Indian arbitral landscape, particularly in light of the 2015 and 2019 Amendments, with special focus on its implications for foreign lawyers and International Commercial Arbitration.

The presentation will be followed by a Q&A session moderated by Sapna Jhangiani, Partner at Clyde & Co Clasis Singapore.

#### **Gourab Banerji**

Gourab Banerji is a Senior Advocate, practicing mainly before the Supreme Court of India and an Overseas Associate of Essex Court Chambers. Graduating from the University of Cambridge in 1989 with First Class Honours, he was called to the Bar from Lincoln's Inn in 1990. He was designated as a Senior Advocate in 2003 and served as the Additional Solicitor General of India from July 2009 to May 2014. In this capacity he represented the Government of India in a number of landmark cases. His practice before the courts is mainly in commercial matters and particularly in arbitration. He has been a part of various committees and assisted the Law Commission in its reports relating to arbitration and also appeared as counsel and arbitrator in a number of domestic and international commercial and treaty arbitrations.
