15/05/20	STAGE ONE – EXAMINATION <p>Candidates will not be required to physically attend an examination as part of Stage 1. Like a real arbitrator, candidates receive the papers in the case by email on this date. Candidates are advised to make use of the time in preparation for Stage 2.</p>
29/05/20	STAGE TWO – EXAMINATION <p>Stage 2 consists of a classroom examination in open book conditions. Candidates will have 4 hours to complete the examination and are permitted to use laptops for examinations. Results are dispatched to candidates normally eight to twelve weeks from the date of the conclusion of the examination.</p>
