19/07/19	STAGE TWO – EXAMINATION Stage 2 consists of a classroom examination in open book conditions. Candidates will have 4 hours to complete the examination and are permitted to use laptops for examinations. <i>Results are dispatched to candidates normally eight to twelve weeks from the date of the conclusion of the examination.</i>
